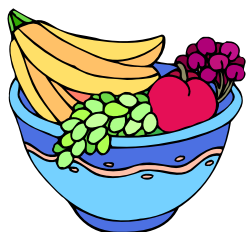


Goodbye, Thank You and Good Luck to Mrs Daurie.

Packed Lunches

If your child stays for lunch at pre-school you need to provide the packed lunch in a clearly labeled box or bag. We encourage parents to think about what they are putting in their children's lunchboxes. Please try and provide your child with a balanced diet as a good diet promotes a good brain. We request that you DO NOT send your child with sweets please as this is not nutritional. Maltesers, Skittles, Mars Bars, fizzy sweets will be all sent home uneaten as they are not an integral part of lunch. Cake bars are fine (for example, Mini Rolls, Jaffa Cake Bars, Penguin). Please DO NOT pack any nut containing products into your child's lunch box (this includes peanut butter sandwiches) as we currently have someone with a nut allergy at the pre-school.

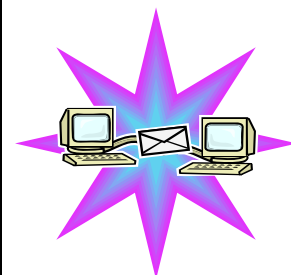
